**Training to institutes of Pune region for Government Scholarship Schemes of

Total 383 representative from 342 institutes under Technical Education Department & 24 representative from institutes under other than Technical Education Department were present.

Following queries are raised during training programme:

1. Students can't apply due to non-availability of Caste Validity for other schemes.
2. For many courses yet fee approval from Fee Regulating Authority, Mumbai (FRA) is awaited or correction in fees from FRA is awaited.
3. Disbursement report in institute login should be modified, because it is very difficult for the institute to track the amount received in their bank statement.
4. SMS to stakeholder i.e. student and institute is not delivered.
5. Aadhar attached mobile number is now not available with students. Hence such students can't retrieve their login ID & Password.
6. Some institutes from other department required other fee correction. There should be perfect guidelines for each activity on the portal.
7. There should be reject option available to institutes for the rejection of second installment of candidates, who are detained or not appeared for exam or any other appropriate reason.
8. Message coming in notification to the candidate/institute is not clear. There should be advice in message against that notification.
9. Date of institute scrutiny is closed but portal is allowing candidates (whose applications were sent back) to re-apply even if scrutiny date is closed. Therefore re-apply option to the students should be closed.
10. Regional Office Pune of DTE has recommended with documents for tuition fee corrections of some institutes in Pune region to FRA through DTE. But as on 04.06.2019, no fee correction is made. Hence, it is not possible to forward students applications for second installment.
