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
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Minutes of Pre-Meeting for Industry Institute Interaction Meet – 2019 held on 31st July, 2019 at K.J.E.I., Pune

DTE Industry Institute Interaction Pre-Meet was conducted on Wednesday, 31/07/2019 at KJCOEMR Seminar Hall. This meeting is conducted under the leadership of Prof. C. T. Kunjir, Incharge Joint Director, DTE, Dr. H. K. Abhyankar, Executive Director, KJEI. The meet is graced by the presence of Hon. Kalyan Jadhav, President, KJEI, Mr. Vinod Jadhav, Treasurer, KJEI, Mrs. Harshada Jadhav, Managing Director, KJEI, the Principals, TPOs and the representatives of Various Engineering Institutes in Pune Region. The minutes of meeting are listed below:

1. The agenda of the meeting is explained by the undersigned and briefed about the industry institute interaction meet scheduled on 11 August 2019 at KJEI Campus. The basic idea of such meet is derived from examples like B. V. Bhoomiraddi College of Engineering, Hubli where 100 startups are established and 600 job opportunities are created for the students.
2. Dr. Hemant Abhyankar, Executive Director, KJEI, appreciated the opportunity given by DTE to KJEI to host industry institute interaction meet. The admissions to Engineering courses from last five years are considerably declined, to change this scenario institutes shall prove that they are enough to produce employable engineers. All the Principals, TPOs and Head of Departments shall identify industry persons and ensure their maximum participation in the meet. He appealed all institutes in Pune region to come forward, book stalls & exhibit their projects and innovations to the polytechnic & engineering students.
3. Prof. C. T. Kunjir, Incharge Joint Director, DTE explained the background and elaborated the entire idea of the meet. Majority of the Engineering Colleges specially those located in villages and outskirts of cities are facing the problems of admissions, placements, staff salaries etc. leading to the serious issue of their survival. Solution must be drawn by Management & Faculties collectively to make the colleges self-sustained with the help of industries. The industry institute interaction meet is scheduled to derive the solution. In the meet key note addresses will be delivered by resource persons like Mr. Anand Joshi, Sandip Inamdar, Sanjay Inamdar & others on topics like Reverse Engineering, Import Substitution, Industry based projects & various case studies will be discussed. The main focus in entrepreneurship development & creation of commercially viable new products. If this is implemented successfully in institutes, faculty can generate revenues and become self sustainable. In this meet 500 resource persons from industry are expected to participate, 12 TEQIP Colleges will have stalls. All institutes in Pune region are expected to have stalls in the meet.

4. Dr. B. P. Ronge, Principal, SVERI COE Pandharpur explained recession is the main cause of poor placements which in turn adversely affected admissions. Lack of administrative training, Faculty turnover rate are the other problems faced by institutes. Measures to be taken to overcome these problems. There are opportunities in recession also, try to grasp these opportunities.
5. Dr. P. W. Wani, Ex-Dean, Engineering Faculty, SPPU, added that today's situation is arrived because industry & institutes had not shared their ideas with each other from independence to till today. Apex bodies like NAAC, NBA, AICTE demands outcome based education. The outcome is not only measured in terms of number of placements offered, number of students going to higher education, entrepreneurs created but also in terms of efforts taken to impart skills to the students. New & updated syllabus should be framed as per the requirement of industry & for this team work & contribution from all are essential. Management had fulfilled our expectations & now its our turn to fulfill their expectations.
6. Dr. A. M. Fulambarkar, Principal, PCCOE focused on what we can offer to industry rather than what industry can offer to us. We shall regularly approach industry to enhance our academics. Work in such a way that industry can realize our potential & approach us.
7. Dr. Kakare Madam suggested that institute should follow timelines to complete the industry jobs and consultancy to gain the confidence. EDC cell shall invite alumni entrepreneurs for guidance. Focus on project mentorships to create technically strong students.
8. Mr. Sheetalkumar Rawandale highlighted demand supply gap in relation to placements. There is need to create job creators rather than job seekers. So each institute should fix some target of creating entrepreneurs.
9. Hon. Kalyan Jadhav, President, KJEI said that business grows on quality, passion, hardwork & dedication. Inculcate these qualities to students along with English speaking skills. He appealed to organize III Meet on monthly basis.
10. In the Principals panel discussion it is proposed that the theme of the meet should be related to topics
 - a. Reverse Engineering for Import Substitution
 - b. Industry based Projects/Incubation Innovation based projects
 - c. Industry Skill development
 - d. ConsultancyThe competent authorities from MCCIA, CII, MSME & Large scale industry to be invited for guidance.
11. Hon. Vinod Tawade, Minister, Higher & Technical Education, Dr. Abhay Wagh, Director DTE will grace the III Meet. All principals, TPOs, Head of departments should take genuine efforts for grand success of this meet.
